DECISION AND STATEMENT OF REASONS OF APPOINTED PERSON

DECISION

1. Upon consideration of the letter of the Appellant sent to the GLA dated 29th April 2009, and the response letter of the GLA on 5th May 2009, it is the decision of the Appointed Person that the Appeal shall be dismissed but that such dismissal shall not take effect until 7th July 2009.
2. In the event that the grant of a new licence be delayed by no unreasonable default of the Appellant, the Appellant and the GLA shall have permission to apply to the Appointed Person to extend the time at which the dismissal shall take effect. If no such application for extension is made by 7th July 2009 the dismissal shall take effect on that date.

REASONS

1. This is an appeal against the decision of the Gangmasters' Licensing Authority (GLA) to revoke the Licence of Riccadonna Produce without immediate effect.
2. The parties have agreed through solicitors' correspondence, that the appeal will be withdrawn as the Appellant has applied for a new Licence. The parties have agreed that the revocation of the previous Licence shall not take effect until the grant of the new licence. It is anticipated that this should be secured by 7th July 2009. In the event that the licence is delayed, the parties may seek an extension until the dismissal takes effect. This must be done by 7th July 2009.
3. Without such an extension the original date of dismissal stands.

DECISION AND STATEMENT OF REASONS OF APPOINTED PERSON

DECISION

1. Upon consideration of the letter of the Appellant sent to the GLA dated 29th April 2009 and the response letter of the GLA on 8th May 2009 it is the decision of the Appointed Person that the Appeal shall be dismissed but that such dismissal shall not take effect until 7th July 2009.

2. In the event that the grant of a new licence be delayed by no unreasonable amount of time the Appellant, the Appellant and the GLA shall have permission to apply to the Appointed Person to extend the time at which the dismissal shall take effect. If no such application for extension is made by 7th July 2009 the dismissal shall take effect on that date.

REASONS

1. This is an appeal against the decision of the Gangmasters' Licensing Authority (GLA) to revoke the Licence of Respondent's Produce without immediate effect.

2. The parties have agreed through solicitors correspondence that the appeal will be withdrawn as the Appellant has applied for a new licence.
